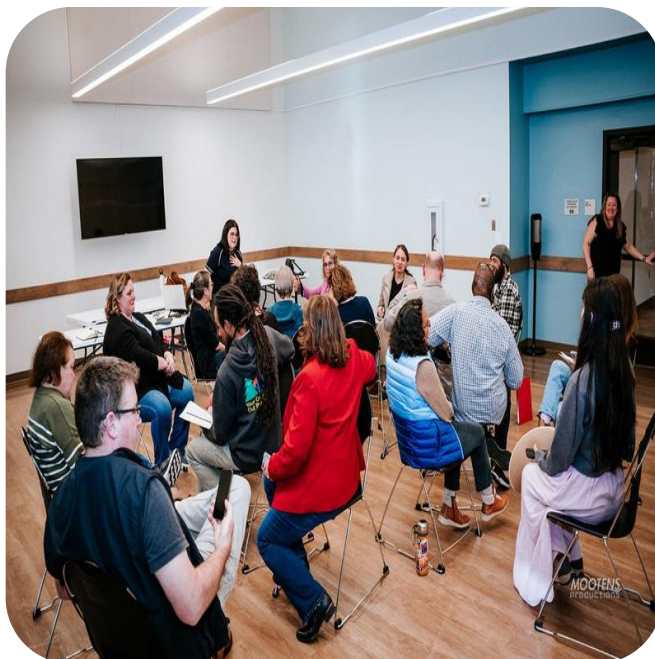

# Programs & Events



## We Prosper Together 2025

- YCF is supporting 5 projects doing work through We Prosper Together initiative as the Yolo County Community Ambassador.
- Local nonprofits such as YCCA and Yolo FoodHub are among the projects YCF is working with.

## NPLA 2025

- YCF provided 9 NPLA sessions for nonprofit learning and collaboration.
- 6 of the sessions were in partnership with Yolo NEON programming.
- Over 60 nonprofits attended at least 1 NPLA event in 2025.



# Programs

## Yolo NEON

- YCF provided 3 cohorts training in the areas of Finance & Accounting, HR & Legal Compliance, and Information Technology & Management.
- The cohort model served 24 nonprofits across Yolo County.
- Yolo NEON collaborated with YCF's established NPLA program to provide 9 additional stand alone workshops. Serving over 55 unduplicated nonprofits across Yolo County.
- A Resource Library was built that currently houses 23 resources from the cohort trainings and an additional 26 resources from the NEON/NPLA trainings.
- 36 hours of cohort training and 26 hours of consultation was delivered for cohort participants.
- 17 hours of NEON/NPLA training provided by subject matter experts to participating nonprofits.
