**Resolution Certifying Yolo County's Maintained Mileage for
Caltrans to Submit to FHWA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 23 - Code of Federal Regulations section 460.3(b), each state is required to annually certify their public road mileage to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA); and

WHEREAS, the FHWA has set June 1st as the deadline for receiving these certifications; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code section 2121, each city and county is required to certify their maintained public road mileage each year in May and identify the additions and deletions from the previous year's certification; and

WHEREAS, the County of Yolo "Maintained Mileage Database" is kept current by staff in the Department of Community Services, Public Works Division, and staff has prepared a certified maintained mileage report that includes all of the information required by California Streets and Highways Code section 2121.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works recommends that the following road segments be removed from the County Maintained Road System and transferred to the City of Woodland, consistent with Yolo Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) annexation described below:

1. 1266' Portion of CR 100A south of CR 25A.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors may, by resolution, terminate the maintenance of any county highway in accordance with section 945.5 of the Streets and Highways Code; and

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2024, LAFCo adopted Resolution 2024-07 approving the Woodland Research and Technology Park Reorganization to the City of Woodland (LAFCo No. 23-07), which included the transfer of road maintenance responsibilities of the previously mentioned road segments (Portion of CR 100A south of CR 25A.) to the City of Woodland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

1. The County of Yolo as of December 31, 2024 maintains 751.479 total miles of roads.
2. The County of Yolo as of December 31, 2025 maintains 751.240 total miles of roads.
3. The change in the number of currently maintained miles is due to corrections made as a result of the City of Woodland's annexation of lands that were previously County highways.
4. The Yolo County Department of Community Services, Public Works Division is authorized and directed to send the annual certified maintained mileage report and this Board Resolution to Caltrans pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code section 2121.
