

RESOLUTION NO. _____

(Resolution Increasing the DA’s FY25/26 Budget by \$10,650 for Victim/Witness Assistance Program)

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney applied for and received grant funding from the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services for Victim/Witness Assistance Program. These funds are used to provide comprehensive services to victims of violent crimes within Yolo County; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services has made available funding for the grant period of October 1, 2024, to September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney was awarded, by the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services, \$447,693 for the duration of the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Yolo County District Attorney’s office has modified the grant’s budget to purchase computers for the Victim/Witness Assistance Program with existing revenues approved for the program; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the computers was not included in FY25/26 adopted budget; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to increase appropriation in the amount of \$10,650; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 29125 and 29130 authorize changes to an adopted budget in certain circumstances by a four-fifth vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The Department of Financial Services is authorized to amend the estimated appropriation and revenues in fiscal year 2025-26 as follow:


