Milestone	Date	Details	Elections Code
<b>Resolution</b>	<b>July 6, 2026</b> (120 days and no less than 115 before election):	Deadline to have the measure resolution filed with the Board of Supervisors and a copy given to the elections office. <b>(Closest Board Meeting date is 6/23)</b>	
<b>Arguments regarding measure</b>	<b>August 7th, 2026</b> (88 days before election):	Deadline for any arguments regarding the measure	EC § 10403
<b>Deadline for any rebuttals</b>	<b>August 17th, 2026</b> (78 days before election):	Mandated 10-calendar day public examination period and mail the County Voter Information Guides.	EC § 10403
<b>Election Day</b>	<b>Nov 3, 2026</b>	Statewide general election: measures appear on the ballot if all steps are met.
