WHEREAS, Dr. Sisson attained a Bachelor of Science Degree at Loyola Marymount University, a Doctor of Medicine degree at the Davis Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA, and a Master's Degree in Public Health and Epidemiology at the University of California, Davis; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sisson has excelled at safeguarding the well-being of Yolo County residents by providing timely and trustworthy information to healthcare providers, the Yolo County Board of Supervisors and Yolo County Health Council, and the general public about emerging issues, ensuring that underserved populations are not neglected, collaborating with community partners and other County Departments, and serving on multiple steering committees to develop better services; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sisson valiantly led the Yolo County response to the COVID-19 pandemic, working tirelessly to develop new protocols, build community trust, implement plans, and provided the Board of Supervisors with the technical expertise needed to make difficult decisions; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sisson has accepted the call to lead the new Trauma Mitigation and Response Unit at the California Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sisson is a dedicated health and human services professional who has employed collaborative approaches that improve client services and outcomes and demonstrated unparalleled dedication to the well-being of our community during the most challenging times in recent history.
