Resolution	July 6, 2026 (120 days and no less than 115 before election):	Deadline to have the measure resolution filed with the Board of Supervisors and a copy given to the elections office. (Closest Board Meeting date is 6/23)	
Arguments regarding measure	August 7th, 2026 (88 days before election):	Deadline for any arguments regarding the measure	EC § 10403
Deadline for any rebuttals	August 17th, 2026 (78 days before election):	Mandated 10-calendar day public examination period and mail the County Voter Information Guides.	EC § 10403
Election Day	Nov 3, 2026	Statewide general election: measures appear on the ballot if all steps are met.
