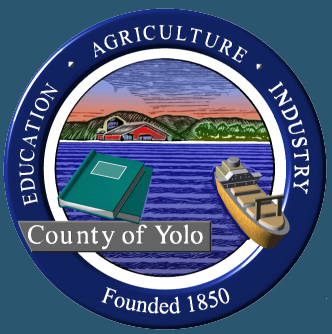

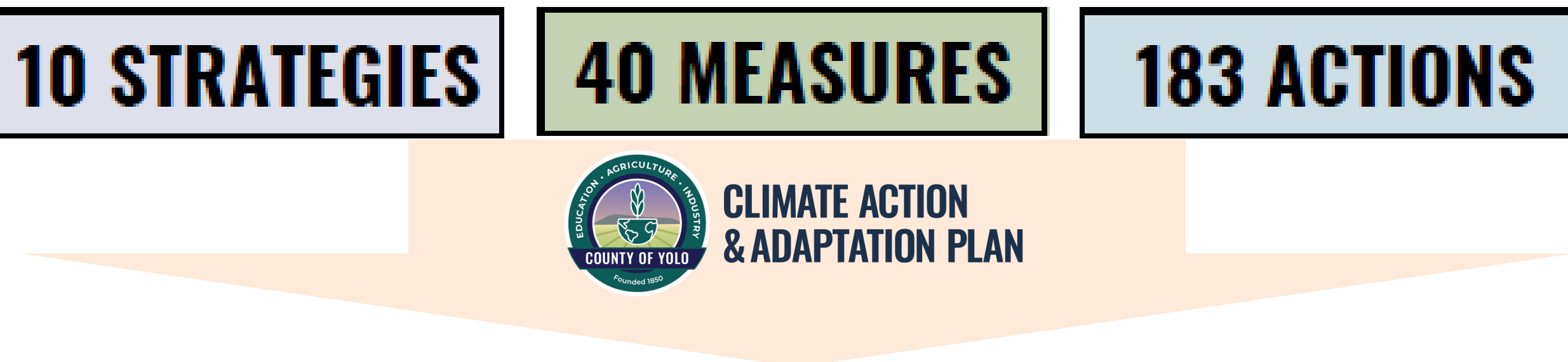

The Milestones

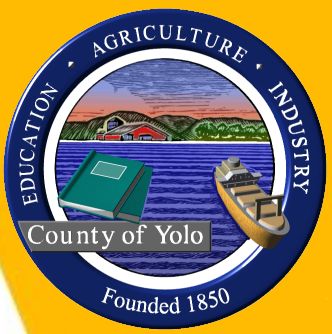
- Yolo County Climate Action and Adaptation Plan (CAAP) adopted by Board on **December 3, 2024**.
- Implementation officially began **January 1, 2025**.
- Phase 1 of Implementation: **2025 – 2027**.



Goal: **net-negative** GHG Emissions by **2030** while centering equity and ensuring a Just Transition.

- ✓ **20** YEP events hosted by County + CBO Partners.

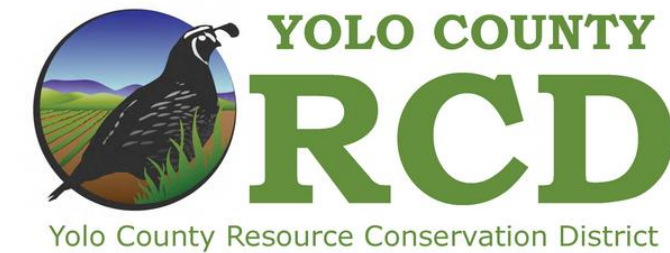

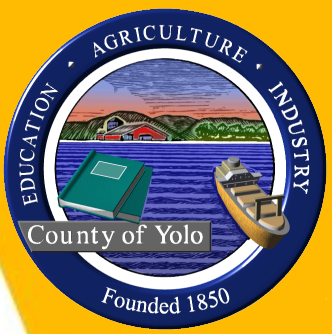

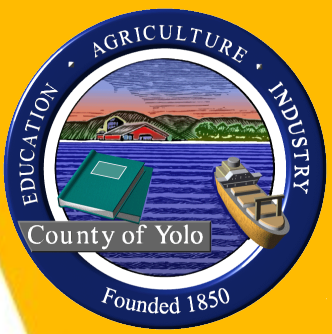

Advanced 20+ CAAP
Phase I Actions



- **Davis Bike Campaign:** 1,000 students trained in road safety in Washington USD + Winters JUSD; 50 balance bikes distributed to students in Knights Landing + Winters.
- **CCYS:** Engaged 946 community members in bilingual disaster prep. education.
- **De Colores:** Surveyed 195 farmworkers on transportation needs.
- **Yolo Food Bank:** Produced 6,477 lbs of fresh, culturally-diverse produce.
- **Yolo RCD/CLBL:** Provided carbon farming TA to 16 producers, 1,500 linear ft of hedgerows planned, ~1,814 MT CO₂e potential sequestration.

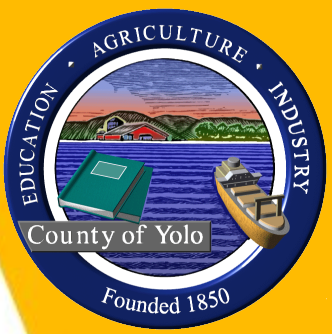




Leading By Example: County Operations

- ✓ 25-member interdepartmental Green Team drives internal accountability.
- ✓ DGS/DCS installed **17 new EV chargers** (3 County facilities + 14 public).
- ✓ IWM completed **340 “flip-the-lid”** household recycling compliance inspections.
- ✓ **Agricultural Equipment Replacement (AER) Pilot Completed.**
- ✓ **Fossil Fuel Inventory & Feasibility Study Completed.**
- ✓ **Zero Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Action Plan Completed.** *(Coming to BOS in August '26)*

Regional Leadership & Recognition



- **Yolo County Regional Resilience Collaborative** grew to 11 partners.

- Identified 9 priority resilience projects selected from 28 proposals.



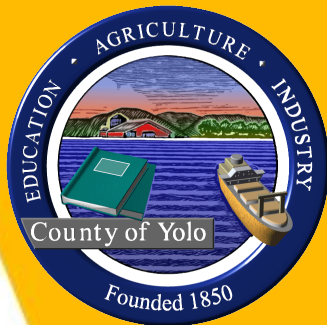

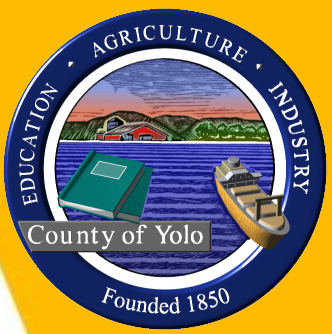

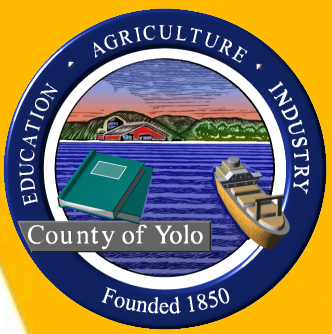

2026-2027 Priorities & Next Steps

- Green Team + partners identified **66** priority actions to advance across **29** measures; Spanning all **10** strategies.
- **Focus areas:**
 - Transportation: ZEV Action Plan implementation, e-bike incentive rollout.
 - Buildings & Energy: YEP/weatherization expansion, Implementation of Inventory and Feasibility Study, NREN territory expansion.
 - Natural & Working Lands: carbon farming, groundwater recharge.
 - Waste: school organics education, C&D diversion certification.
 - Resilience: Advancing Regional Resilience Collaborative priority projects, resilience center funding, expanding urban tree canopy.
- **Climate Action Commission** Relaunches on July 21, 2026.
