RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO LIEN DELINQUENT SOLID WASTE SERVICE CHARGES AND
SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR JULY 21, 2026

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 25828 establishes a procedure for confirming delinquent charges for certain services, including the solid waste collection and recycling services covered by Title 6, Chapter 17 of the Yolo County Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25828 and Yolo County Code Section 6-17.507, upon the confirmation of delinquent charges by the Yolo County Board of Supervisors, the delinquent sums thereafter constitute special assessments and are a lien on the respective parcels of land.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo hereby resolves as follows:

1. The Board hereby accepts the attached report of delinquent solid waste and late penalty charges, which have been delinquent for more than 365 days.

2. The Board of Supervisors further sets July 21, 2026 at the hour of 9:00 a.m. in the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo in the County Administration Building at 625 Court Street in the City of Woodland, California, as the time and place where any and all persons having objections to the proposed collection of delinquent solid waste charges and late penalty on the property tax roll may appear before this Board and show cause why the proposed action herein described should not be carried out in accordance with this Resolution of Intention. If confirmed, such charges shall constitute special assessments against the respective parcels of land and are a lien on the property for the amount of the delinquent charges pursuant to Government Code section 25828.

2. The Board of Supervisors gives notice that any owner of property liable to be assessed for a delinquent refuse charge may, at any time not later than the hour set for hearing objections to the proposed collection of such delinquent charges on the property tax roll, make and file with the Clerk of this Board a written protest against the proposed action herein described or against the amount of such charges or both.

3. The Board of Supervisors direct the Yolo County Division of Integrated Waste Management to mail affected property owners notice no less than 10 days prior to the public hearing.

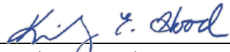
