

**BOARD OF EDUCATION
ESPARTO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
RESOLUTION NO. 2025/26-13**

(Resolution Ordering Governing Board Member Election and Requesting the
Yolo County Board of Supervisors to Consolidate District Election with
Regular Election Held on November 3, 2026)

WHEREAS, a regular biennial election for governing board members of the Esparto Unified School District is to be held on November 3, 2026; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the District election be consolidated with the regular election to be held on the same date, and that within the Esparto Unified School District the precincts, polling places, and election officers of the two elections be the same, that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors canvass the returns of the District election, and that the District election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED, AND FOUND BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE ESPARTO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to Education Code Sections 5304 and 5320 et seq., an election is hereby ordered to be held on November 3, 2026 to fill the offices of the Esparto Unified School District Board of Education members whose terms expire this year.
2. The Yolo County Clerk is hereby requested to conduct the election and provide all related election services.
3. If there is a tie vote that makes it impossible to determine which of two or more candidates has been elected, the winner or winners shall be determined by lot.
4. The candidates, including incumbents, will pay the costs of publishing the candidate's statement included with the sample ballot, which statement shall not exceed 200 words.
5. The Yolo County Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to consent, agree to, and order the consolidation of the District's governing board member election with the regular election to be

held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, that only one form of ballot be used, and that the elections be held in all respects as one election.

6. The Yolo County Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the District election.
7. The Yolo County Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to authorize and direct the Clerk to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.
8. The Esparto Unified School District hereby agrees to reimburse the County of Yolo for the costs of such election.
9. The Clerk of this Board is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Resolution with the Yolo County Board of Supervisors and the County Clerk or Registrar of Voters.
