

**RESOLUTION CALLING DISTRICT SPECIAL ELECTION AND REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION WITH THE
GENERAL ELECTION**

RESOLUTION NO. 5.19.26.2

WHEREAS, *During the 2025 Uniform District Election Law (UDEL), One board seat was not filled due to a lack of candidates; and*

WHEREAS, *the Board of Directors of the Knights Landing Community Service District did not appoint a new board member within the allowable time frame of 60 days; and*

WHEREAS, *the Yolo County Board of Supervisors did not appoint a new board member within the allowable 30 days following.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED *that the Knights Landing Community Service District requests the Elections Official of the County of Yolo, as prescribed by Elections Code Section 10400, to consolidate with the regularly scheduled General Election and with any other elections to be held on November 3rd, 2026; and*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED *that the Knights Landing Community Service District is to pay for the publication of the Candidate's Statement, pursuant to Elections Code Section 13307(a){1}; and that the limitation on the number of words that a candidate may use in his/her candidate's statement is 200 words; and*

BE FURTHER RESOLVED *that the Knights Landing Community Service District agrees to reimburse the Elections Official for costs accrued, such cost to be calculated by the method set forth in the County's current Election Cost Allocation Procedures.*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED *that in the event of a tie vote per Elections Code §§ 10551. If a tie makes it impossible to determine which of two or more candidates has been elected, the county elections official shall notify the board of directors of the district thereof, and the board of directors shall forthwith notify the candidates who have received the tie votes to appear before it either personally or by representative at a time and place designated by the board of directors. The board of directors shall, at that time and place, determine the tie by lot and the results thereof shall be declared by the board of directors. The candidate so chosen shall qualify, take office and serve as though elected at the preceding general district election.*
