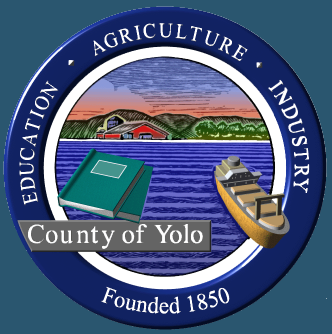

Animal Intakes and Outcomes

June 1–August 31st 2026

Intakes:

- Consistent intakes both from the field and at the shelter
- Increase in litters of puppies being found stray
- Continued requests for owner surrenders related to medical conditions or housing constraints
- Kitten season still going, 165 kittens in foster homes

Outcomes:

- **Adoptions Total:** 682 Dogs: 162 Cats: 520
- **Transferred to Rescue Partners Total:** 118 Dogs: 61 Cats: 57
- New Partnership with Petco in West Sacramento

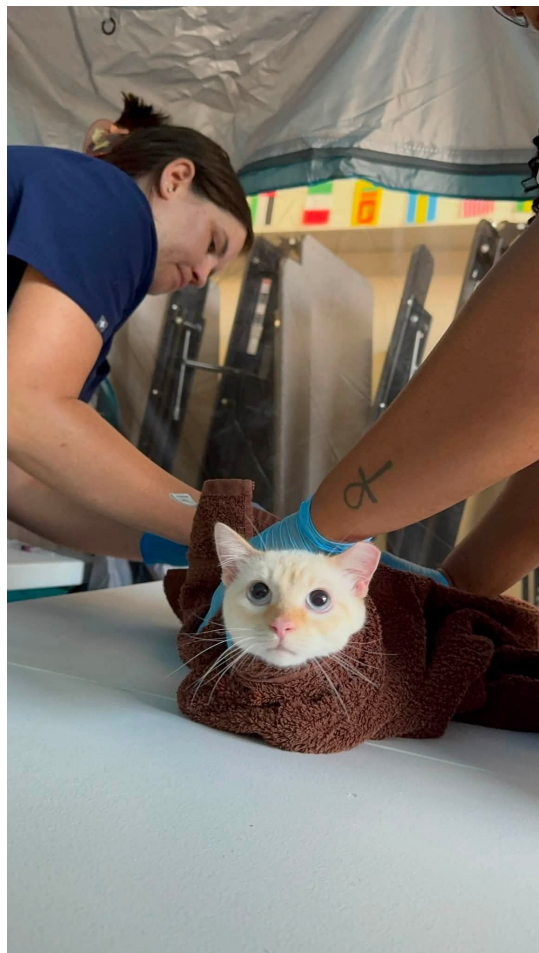

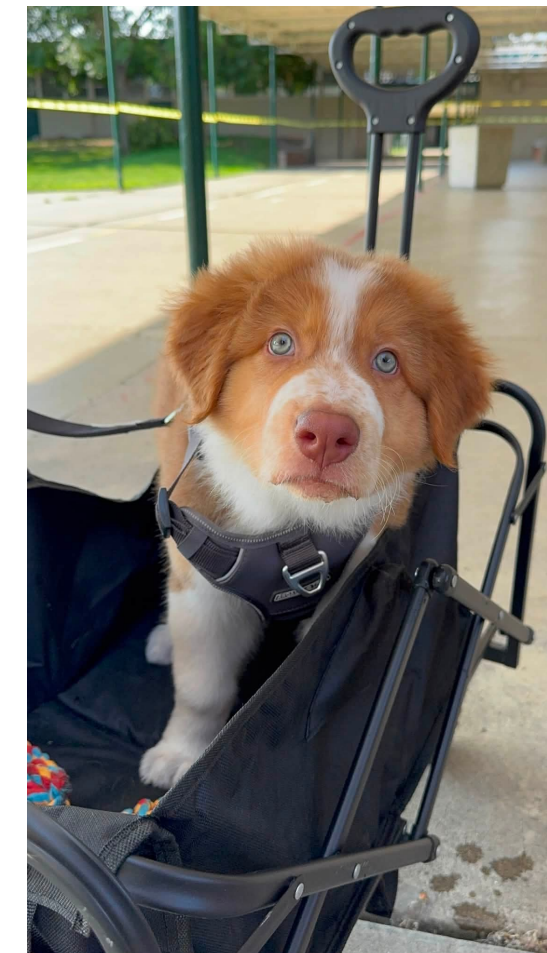
Spay and Neuter:

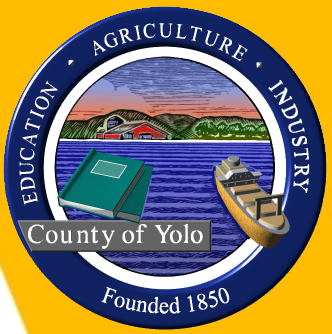
- Community Spay/Neuter Spay Neuter Imperative Project (SNIP)

 - 367 Animals total
 - 235 dogs (Lots of Puppies!)
 - 132 cats
