I believe that there are a number of avenues either available or being worked on to provide affordable alternatives or financial support for spay and neuter.

- a. SNIP – great service, I have used this service. Neuter was very affordable at \$300.
- b. Clinic in a CAN – I believe this is going to go out for RFP
- c. Building A – described by Jill Bonner with UTP as a possibility to be ready right away.
- d. UC Davis Vet School – Yolo County Animal Services has a contract with UCD.

With the possibility of (4) spay/neuter outlets in Yolo County it seems reasonable to assume that spay/neuters will be a lesser worry at some point in the future. The greater worry might be how to create adoptable animals, specifically dogs. What is being done (i.e programs) at the Shelter to create a more adoptable dog? What kind of program, with support, is there to create a better circumstance for dogs to be adopted and matched to the right home.
